



## KEEPING HOPE ALIVE Infertility Grant

The Keeping Hope Alive Grant is funded through private and corporate sponsors throughout the year. These funds are awarded as grants. The number of grants awarded, and the amount of each grant will vary each year based on monies raised.

### 2019 Grant Awarded will include:

Monetary cash grant: \$10,000 maximum per grant

### Keeping Hope Alive grants are awarded to individuals who:

- Have a medical diagnosis of infertility
- Demonstrate financial need

### What demonstrates financial need?

- Combined income
- Expenses
- Assets
- Individual Circumstances

Grant money may be applied towards:

- In Vitro Fertilization (IVF)
- Intrauterine Insemination (IUI)
- Frozen Embryo Transfers (FET)

The grant(s) will be awarded at a fundraising event to be held in June of 2019 @ Whistlers Inn (details to follow).

Grant money will be directly distributed to the servicing agency of the individuals. No grants will be directly distributed to grant recipient or private parties. All grant monies must be utilized to pay for services with in the United States and within twelve months from the date awarded. Any funds remaining at the end of the twelfth month will be deposited back into the grant pool to be awarded in the future to individuals diagnosed with infertility. Past procedures or medications cannot be considered.

There will be a \$50.00 application fee for all individuals submitting an application for a grant.

### What does the \$50 application fee include?

1. Review of your full application by the Board of Directors
2. 2 tickets of admission into the Grant Award celebration June 2019 @ Whistlers Inn

### Grant Application Process (Opens 2/15/2019 – 5/15/2019 Closes)

1. 2. An email will be sent to you upon receipt of your application. If any components of the grant application are missing, you will be notified at this time.
  - a. *\*Note: A submitted grant application will not be reviewed until all components of the application and the \$50 fee have been received by the Keeping Hope Alive team.*
3. All applications will be reviewed by the Keeping Hope Alive Team. By **6/1/2018** you will receive an email stating acceptance or denial of your grant application.
